Safe Arkansas Scholarship Requirements

ELIGIBILITY: Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Recipient is a U.S. citizen or otherwise authorized to work in the United States
- Recipient must currently reside or attend school in Arkansas
- Recipient is accepted or will be attending their first year of undergraduate school in the fall of 2018
- Academic achievement as reflected by an undergraduate cumulative minimum 3.0 GPA

REQUIREMENTS: Applicants must submit the following by June 30, 2018:

- A completed Scholarship Application Form
- Create a 30 60 second Public Service Announcement video that highlights the dangers of distracted driving and/or ways that drivers can avoid on-the-road distractions.
- An official and complete copy of High School or most recent Undergraduate transcripts
- A copy of an acceptance letter from an accredited University within Arkansas
- Proof of legal residency in the U.S. (i.e., birth certificate, passport, permanent resident card, etc.)

AWARD:

- Scholarship Award is to be used exclusively for school tuition and related expenses.
- A check for \$2,500 will be made payable to the award recipient's school to cover these expenses.
- Recipient is expected to submit receipts in accordance with IRS regulations.
- Scholarship award recipient will be notified of the selection on or about August 1, 2018.
- Winner will be chosen by our team of attorneys.
